

Should you try to make BMA clauses in your current accounts invalid?

Some consumers have been lucky, and have found that the following notice, included in their bills when you pay them, may make BMA clauses invalid. This may not work, but it's worth a try.

Here's how to do it:

1. On the bottom of your checks, write these words: "Notice the Notice"
2. If possible, make a copy of your notice with the check attached to it.
3. Be sure to get a copy or image of the front of your check after it has been cashed.
4. Print the following letter, and attach it to your check.

I want to opt-out my account number _____ from any arbitration agreement.

If you do not accept this opt-out notice as valid, then notify me in writing within thirty days.
